

MSS Student Participation Grants Guidelines and Submission Information

For the 2021 MSS annual meeting, MSS is providing participation grants to students. This grant will cover the conference registration and/or MSS 2021 one-year membership for up to 400 students. The grant is intended to make the 2021 MSS annual meeting the most accessible academic conference for students. To allow MSS to serve as many students with real need as possible, please be sure to select what type of funding you need for the 2021 annual meeting (Membership & Registration; Registration Only; Membership Only).

Award Application Requirements:

To be eligible for a student participation grant, you must:

1. Be a current MSS member in good standing. Once you have completed the membership form, select the "Invoice Me" option (as opposed to "Pay Now"), as no payment is required until further notice.
2. Register for the annual meeting by February 1. Once you have filled the registration form, select "Invoice Me" option (as opposed to "Pay Now") as payment is not required until further notice.
3. Be listed on the annual meeting program as a presenter, panelist, discussant or organizer.
4. Submit your request per the directions below.

Please follow these directions to submit your request for a student travel grant:

1. Look up the session number(s) in which you're participating. You will find it in the final program (posted online in late January).
2. Apply for MSS Participation Grant through the following form by February 1.

Awardee Selection and Announcement

- If there are more than 400 eligible applicants, the 400 award winners will be randomly drawn from all applicants.
- You will be notified of your award status before the meeting.
- If you have already paid for your membership or registration and are selected as an awardee, the Executive Director will work with you to refund the payment(s) already made.

Withdrawal

- If awardee decides not to attend the meeting or withdraws from the conference, the awardee should inform MSS at once, so that the award can be offered to another applicant.
